- The Division Council Meeting for the month of February will be a fish fry held at the Memorial Park Boys and Girls Club (3535 N. Western). Tony has been asked to lead the group in song and Darrel will be master chef.
- Sponsored youth is now called Service Leadership Programs and includes K Kids, Builders Club, Key Club, and CKI.
- The Midwinter Conference will be held Feb 16-17 at the Westin in Dallas. \$89/night rate. Saturday night there will be a “roasting” of Randy Delay, candidate for International Trustee at this year’s International Convention.
- Divisions are encouraged to maintain a relationship of service with old governor’s projects including CASA and Reach out and Read. This year the Governor’s Project is Salvation Army Disaster Relief.
- Weekend of a Lifetime (WOAL) is this weekend (Jan 26-28). This is a leadership weekend for Key Clubbers and sponsored in part by the Foundation.
- Key Leader is the First Lady’s project this year. It is similar to WOAL, however it is a Kiwanis International program open to all high school students.
