Salvation Army Bell Ringing

Thanks to all those members who helped ring the bell for the Salvation Army on December 21st. The project was a great success. According to Mr. Potter from the Salvation Army, the stations at Pancho's and Union Bank were the most productive ringing stations. Last year the club raised \$817.77 at the two locations. This year a total of \$1,101.47 was raised—\$183.58 per hour. \$860.16 was raised at the Union Bank location with the remaining \$241.31 coming from Poncho's.
